FIrst Day back - Monday 6th September

Staggered start & finish for each class:

5MB - drop off 8.15am/ pick up 2.45pm
5FW - drop off 8.30am/ pick up 3pm
5LE - drop off 8.45am/ pick up 3.15pm
5CS - drop off 9am/ pick up 3.30pm

- <u>Drop off</u>: ONE parent/carer to walk their child round the EMS side of campus & drop off outside Sports Hall - senior staff will guide you
- Pick up: staff will walk the children down and dismiss them from the main gate thank you for being on time for your child's class slot
- No driving/ parking on site lots of space in neighbouring roads

On Monday 6th September

• Full uniform - PE kits stay at home and worn to school on PE days only. (Tutors will advise after the first day).

• What should your child bring to school?

A healthy snack (no nuts or apples please!)

- ✤ a named water bottle
- ✤ a packed lunch
- a sensible pencil case (see full list of stationery in the transition booklet)

• These can be carried in a small bag/ rucksack.

From Tues 7th Sept-Fri 10th Sept (1st week of term)

- Year 5 gate time (all 4 classes): drop-off at 8.15am and finish/ pick-up at 3.30pm
- **Drop off (8.15am):** Pupils will be guided from the main gate by EMS staff, through the Year 5 entrance gate to the tennis courts where they will line up with their Form Tutor
- Pick up (3.30pm): <u>Please organise a place to meet your</u> child outside the school gates. The roads nearby get quite congested, so once they are confident enough, it is advisable to encourage your child to walk, bike or scoot at least part of the way.
- Please remember that we do not allow cars entry to the School Campus at the start and finish of the school day

From Monday 13th Sept onwards drop-off timings TBC

- Drop-off 8.30am with the rest of the school registration at 8.40am - *Timings TBC*
- Drop off: Pupils to walk through the Year 5 entrance gate and into their classes via the Year 5 entrance - guided by Year 5 team
- Pick up (3.30pm): Please continue to arrange a place to meet your child outside the school gates.
