This week in KS2 Science the students got to investigate magnets.



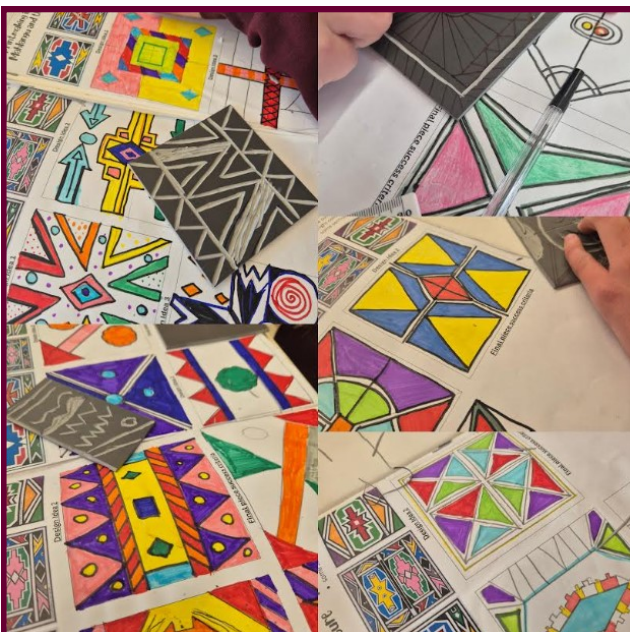
## Panathalon
