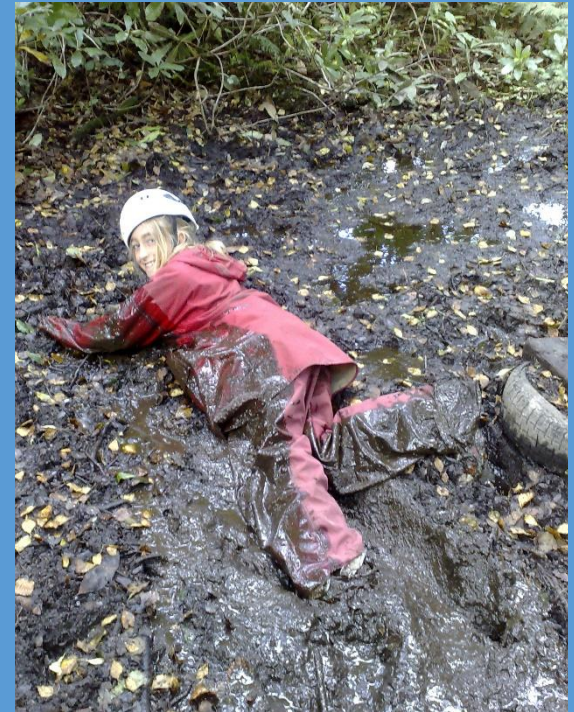

# Key Information - Heatree 2026

- 3 nights (5th - 8th May inclusive - home Friday 8th)
- £350 total cost (£197 if your child is entitled to Free School Meals). Trip is dependent on a minimum number (approx 90 pupils to have a fully contained site)
- Deposit of £60 by **10am Wednesday 1st October** to reserve your child's place (£47 if entitled to Free School Meals)
- **Deposit is non-refundable**
- All payments via parentmail
- Kit list nearer the time - lots of **LABELLED** outdoor clothes and extra shoes!
