SCHOOL DISCO FRIDAY 1ST MARCH 2019

The PTFA will be running a whole school disco for the Year 5, 6, 7 and 8 children on **Friday 1st March 2019 starting at 6.30pm and finishing at 8.30pm**. I would like to point out that Fire Safety regulations dictate that our maximum number in the Hall for a disco is 275 children. Therefore tickets will be on a first come first served basis.

Due to Child Protection and Safeguarding procedures, it is of paramount importance that we ensure the safety of all children attending the disco and the safe return of your child. With this in mind we require the reply slip below to be completed and signed by the child's parent/carer and returned with the money to buy the ticket.

I would like to remind you that mobile phones should only be brought in case of an emergency and if they are brought into school, along with any other personal belongings, the owner does so at their own risk. As stated in the AUP policy taking photos on mobile phones is not permitted on the school premises.

Only one ticket will be sold per child. **Please note that all siblings must have a completed permission slip each. We have attached duplicate slips for this purpose.**

What to do if you purchased a ticket for the disco on 1st February

If your child has already purchased a ticket for the disco on 1st February and would like to attend this disco, please send them in with their 1st February disco ticket and a newly completed permission slip. We are asking for new permission slips to be completed to ensure we have up to date and correct going home arrangements for all pupils. They will then be given a new disco ticket for 1st March. Please don't worry if they have lost their ticket, we have a list of the pupils who purchased one. If they do not wish to attend the disco on 1st March but have already purchased a ticket, they should bring their ticket to the PTFA members, when the new tickets are being sold, for a refund.

All pupils who wish to attend the disco on 1st March must have a new disco ticket. Tickets dated 1st February will not be accepted.

If you purchase a ticket and find you can no longer make it to the Disco please return the ticket to the PTFA so it can be resold. Please do not pass it on to another child as the PTFA will have a waiting list and it will also affect our records of who will be attending the disco.

At the disco pupils will be able to purchase drinks and sweets ranging from 20p to £1.00. They may also buy glow sticks (30p) and other glow products which cost a maximum of £1.50.

When collecting your child at the end we ask that you come into the Hall via the path at the side of the Tennis Courts. Once you have identified your child/children, please go to the supervising adult and sign against their name and then exit through the front entrance.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you in advance for your co-operation in ensuring that your children are safely returned to you.

If there are any changes to the collection arrangements stated on the Disco Permission Slip please let us know as soon as possible.
