Sports Day 2019 - Revised Date

Thank you for your support and understanding with our decision to postpone the Sports Day until Thursday 20th June.

Please find attached list of the event timings. As before KS2 pupils will be taking part in potted sports during the morning. After lunch at 1.00pm the whole school will be outside cheering on their House teams in a mixture of track and field events.

Parents of KS2 pupils are welcome to join us for the potted sports and KS3 parents may come and watch their children taking part in the track and field events in the morning and everyone is welcome to join us for the final events in the afternoon. If you do come and watch we ask that you watch from the designated viewing areas, and stay within these areas during break. We also ask that all parents leave the school at lunchtime between 12.00pm and 12.45pm.

Please note that children should come to school in their PE kit with a top (no vests/strappy tops please) in their house group's colour:

Please also ensure that your child brings plenty to drink, a refillable water bottle is the best option and suitable additional clothing dependant on weather (water proof jacket/sun hat etc).

If you wish to take photographs at the sports days you will be asked to sign a disclaimer stating that if any photographs you take include children other than your own you will seek the permission of the child(ren)'s parents if you wish to use the photographs on social media or in the public domain.

Normally we ask all visitors not to use their mobile telephones on site. However, we understand that this is a very different occasion which is why we have created the signing in process to enable you to use your devices to take photographs at your child's sports day.

There will be some refreshments provided by the PTFA (teas, coffees and small selection of snacks).
