

Administration of Medicines - Isle of Wight Trip

If a child requires medication for a specific medical condition or illness parents needs to complete the parental agreement form. This form together with the medication should be handed into the school office in a named zip lock bag at the very latest BY THURSDAY 27TH JUNE 2019. Please note that we cannot administer aspirin or medicines containing ibuprofen unless they are prescribed by a doctor. All medicines must be in their original containers/boxes. Parents must ensure that any instructions for administration on the parental agreement form (for example dose and/or time between doses) match those detailed on the medication provided. Failure to ensure this may affect our ability to administer the medication.

Please do not send paracetamol in for “just in case” headaches etc. The school will take liquid paracetamol (and strepsils for sore throats) for students for this purpose.

If your child currently has medication held at school and you would like this to be taken on the trip, please inform Mrs Askam in the school office BY TUESDAY 25TH JUNE that this medication needs to be taken.

If your child suffers with asthma and they have a blue/reliever inhaler they may carry this on them. If they take a brown/steroid based inhaler a parental agreement form should be completed and the inhaler handed in.

If parents have any questions about medicines etc they should speak to Mrs Askam in the school office or Mr Foord who is the First Aider for this trip.
