SCHOOL DISCO FRIDAY 4TH OCTOBER 2019

The PTFA will be running a whole school disco for the Year 5, 6, 7 and 8 children on **Friday 4**th **October 2019 starting at 6.30pm and finishing at 8.30pm**. I would like to point out that Fire Safety regulations dictate that our maximum number in the Hall for a disco is 275 children. Therefore tickets will be on a first come first served basis.

Due to Child Protection and Safeguarding procedures, it is of paramount importance that we ensure the safety of all children attending the disco and the safe return of your child. With this in mind we require the reply slip below to be completed and signed by the child's parent/carer and returned with the money to buy the ticket.

I would like to remind you that mobile phones should only be brought in case of an emergency and if they are brought into school, along with any other personal belongings, the owner does so at their own risk. As stated in the AUP policy taking photos on mobile phones is not permitted on the school premises.

TICKETS COST £2.50

(this is a small increase as the PTFA have invested in new lighting to improve the disco atmosphere)

Tickets are not sold at the door or the school office

They can be purchased <u>each lunch break</u> in the KS2 shared area from members of the PTFA from Tuesday 1st October 2019

Pupils must queue and purchase their own ticket
Unfortunately we will be unable to sell tickets to children
without the attached permission slip

Only one ticket will be sold per child. Please note that all siblings must have a completed permission slip each. We have attached duplicate slips for this purpose.

If you purchase a ticket and find you can no longer make it to the Disco please return the ticket to the PTFA so it can be resold. Please do not pass it on to another child as the PTFA will have a waiting list and it will also affect our records of who will be attending the disco.

At the disco pupils will be able to purchase drinks and sweets ranging from 20p to £1.00. They may also buy glow sticks (30p) and other glow products which cost a maximum of £1.50.
