

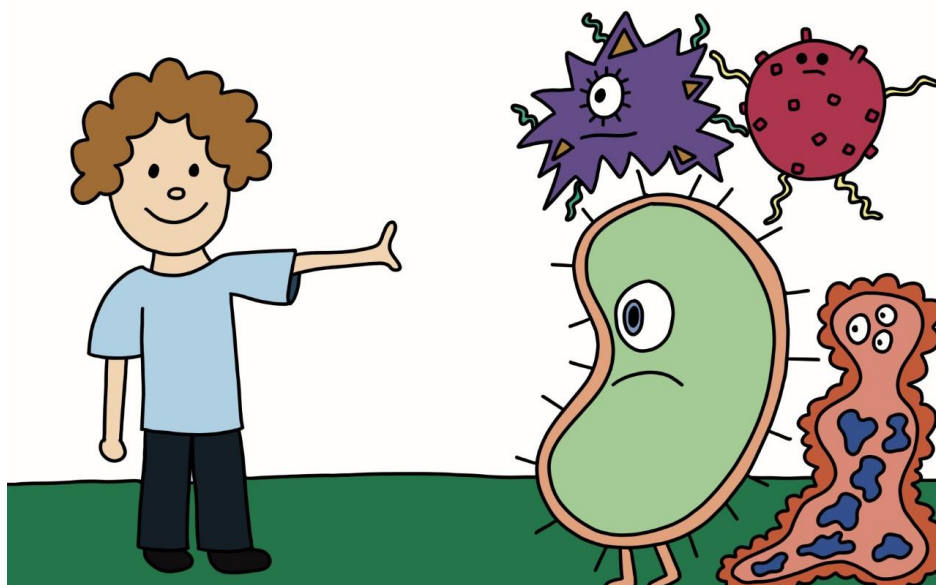
Returning to EMS March 2021



We have done a good job of social distancing and staying at home.



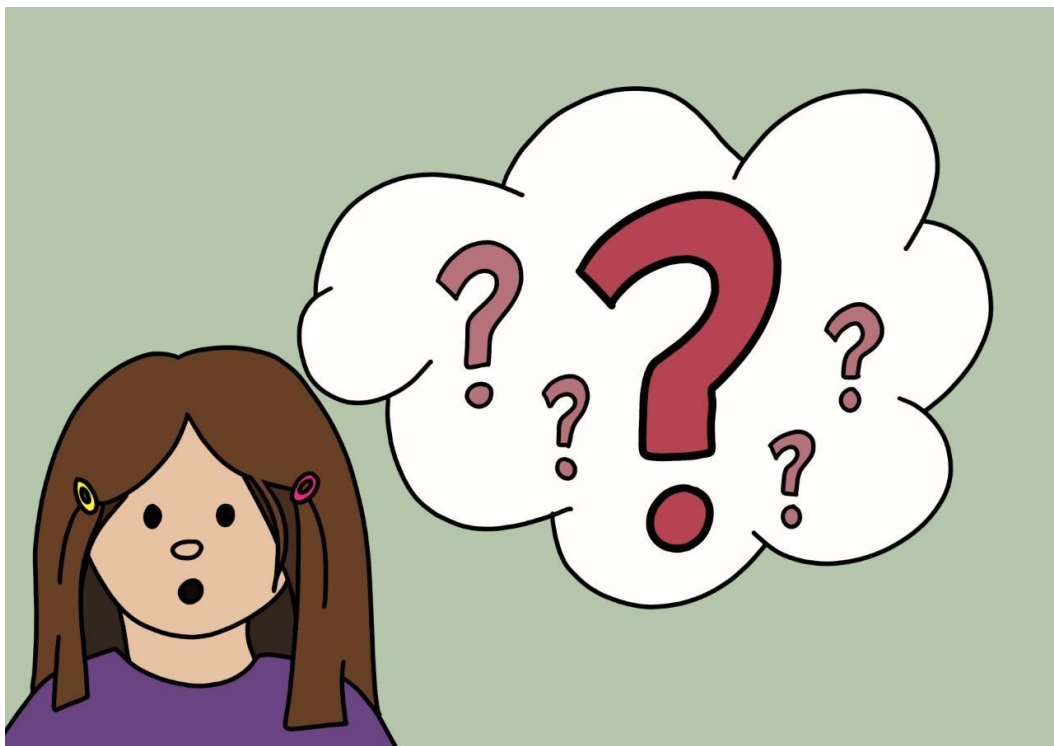
Fewer people are getting sick with the Corona Virus.



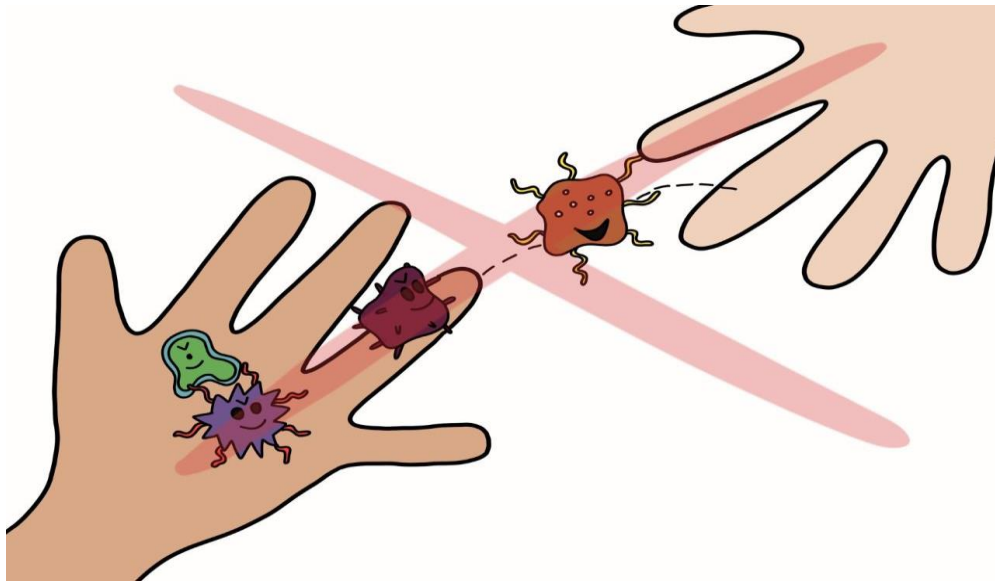
We will be returning to Emmanuel on Monday 8th March!

To keep everyone safe, we still need to be careful so that we don't spread germs at school.



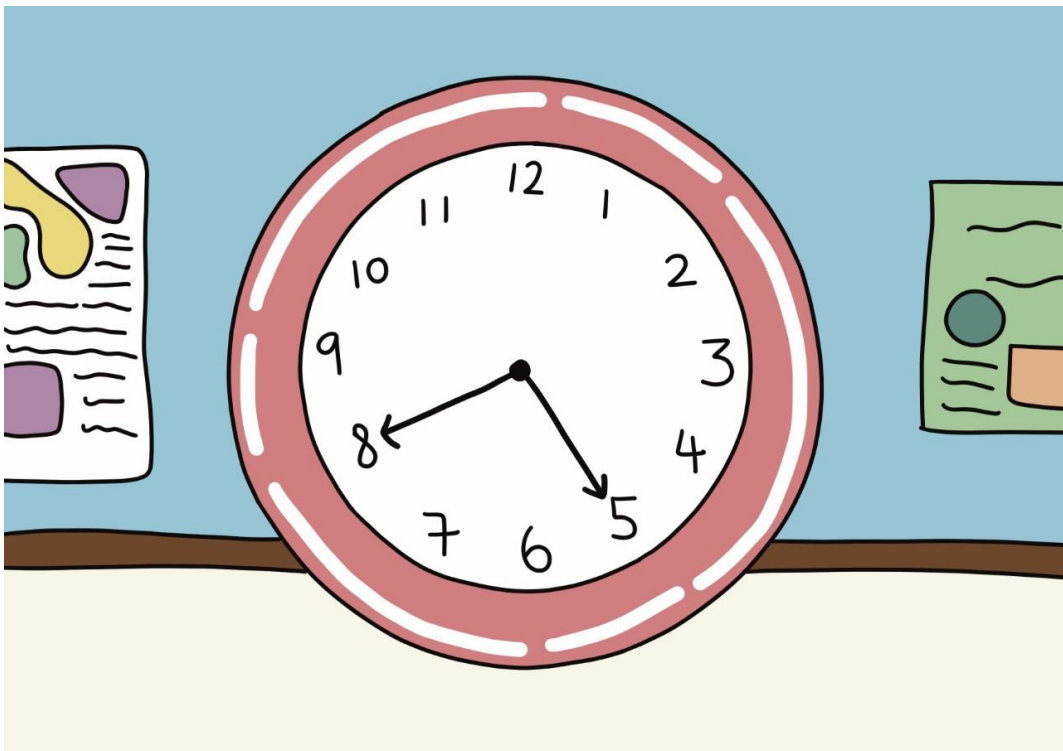
Everyone entering the school needs to make sure that they are healthy.

Pupils will be having their COVID tests in school. If you take a test, this means your Parent/carer has given permission for this.

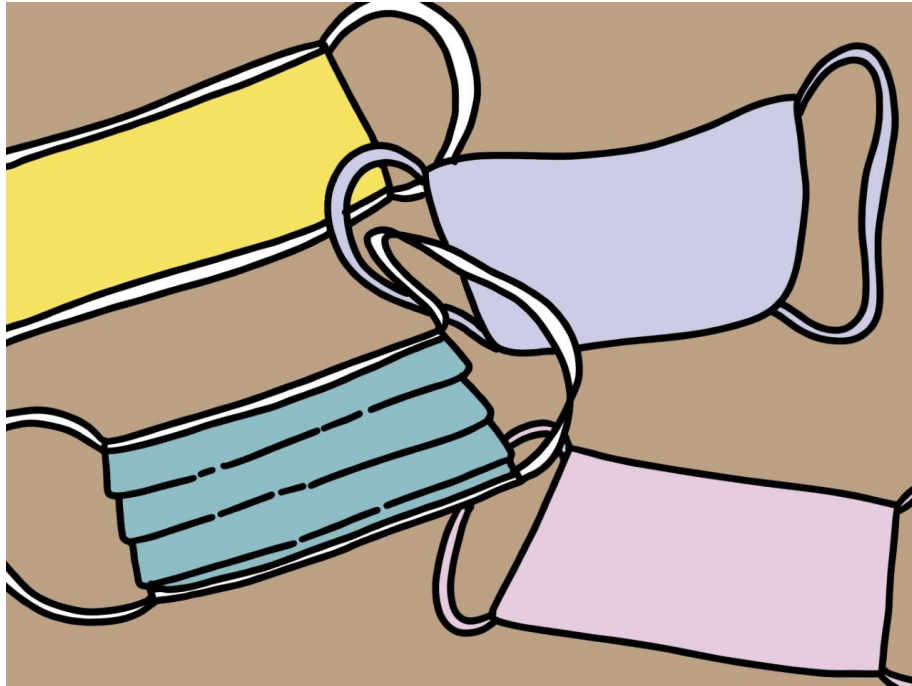


In school we will still be washing our hands regularly.

school. Our masks must be plain.

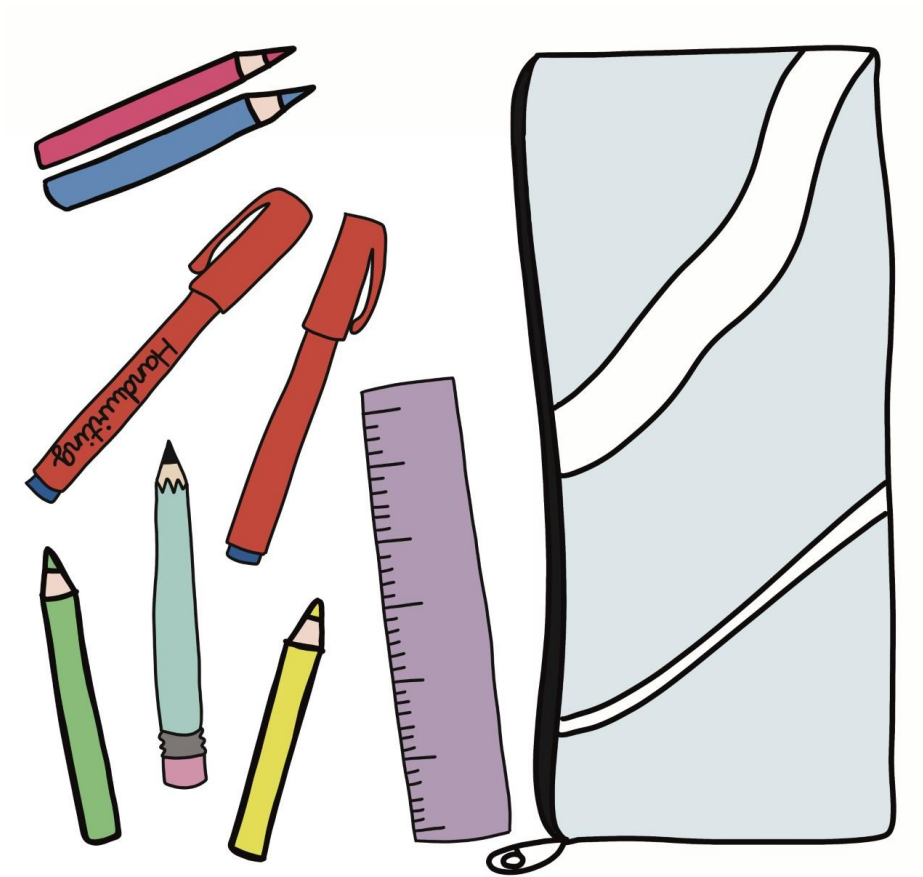


The tables will still be spread out in the classroom.

We will not be able to walk around the classroom.

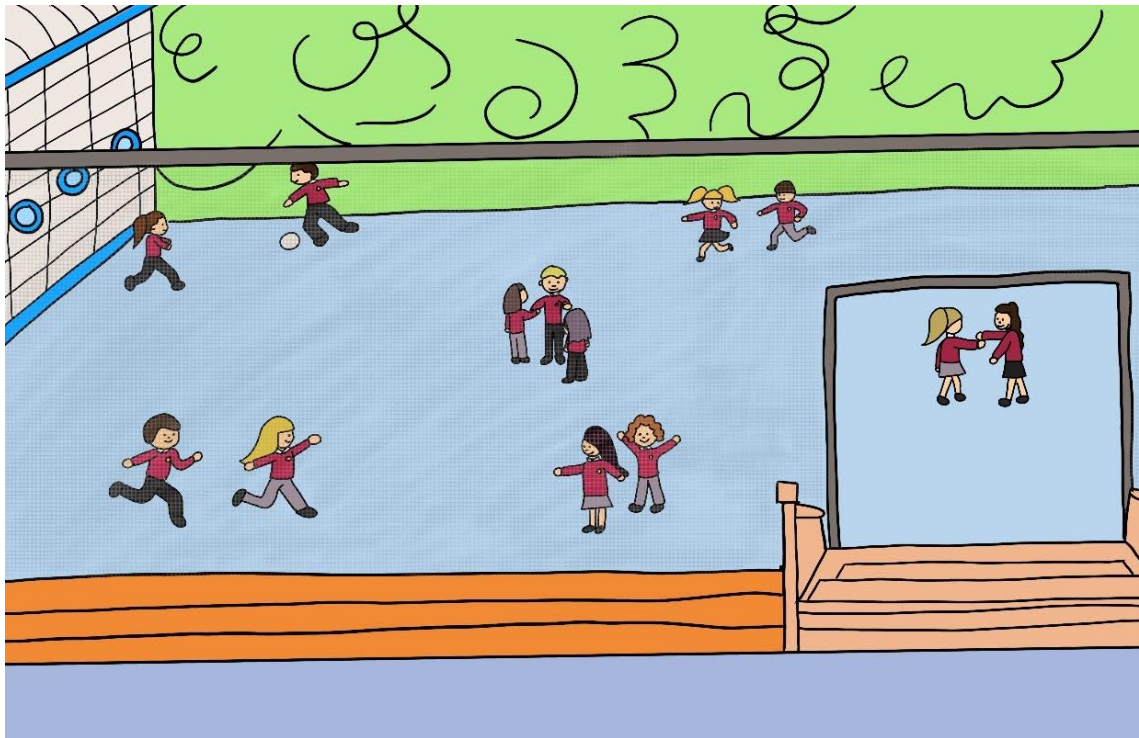


We will be given some supplies but we should now bring our own clear pencil case with a handwriting pen, pencils, coloured pencils and ruler

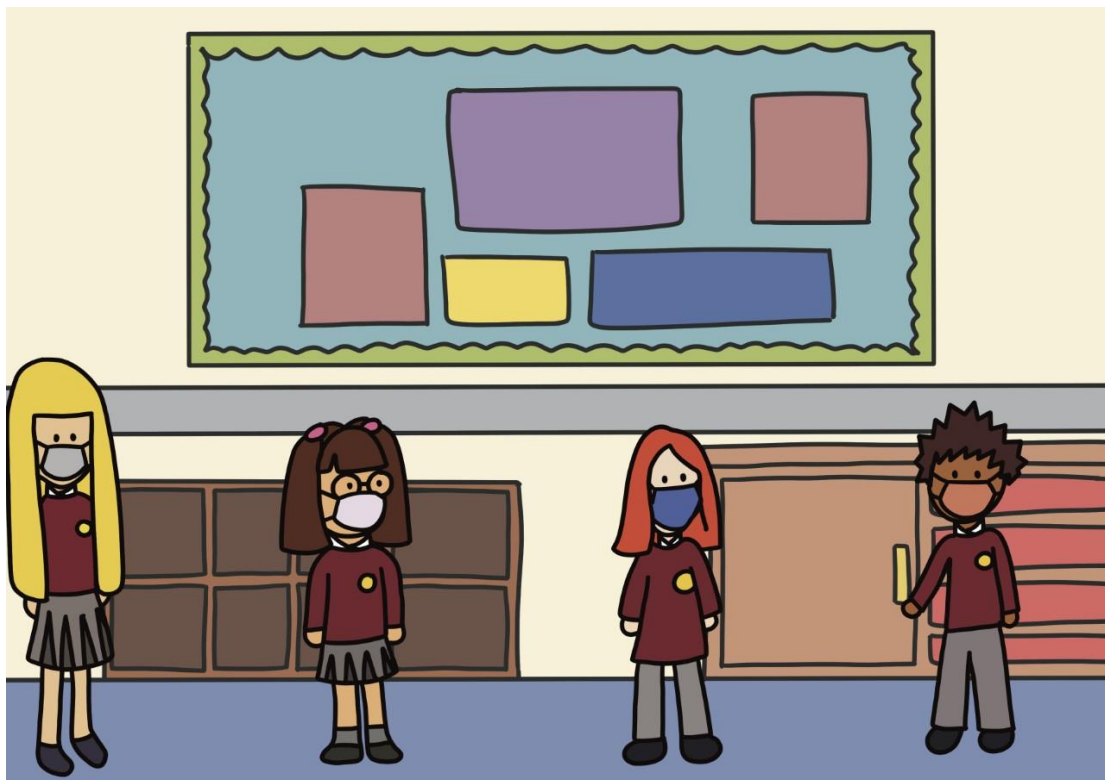


Sports and practical equipment will continue to be thoroughly cleaned between each use.

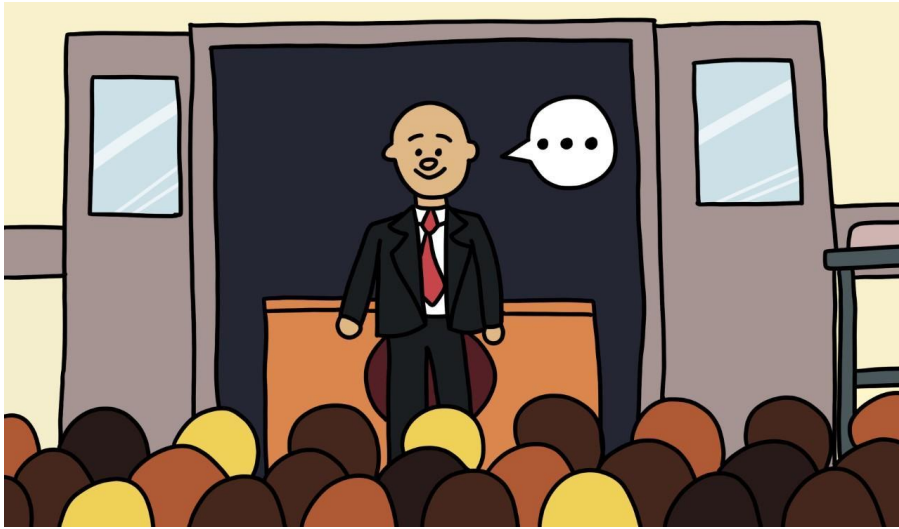
We will still need to physically distance ourselves from others inside and outside the school as much as possible.

We will not be able to hold hands or hug others in school.



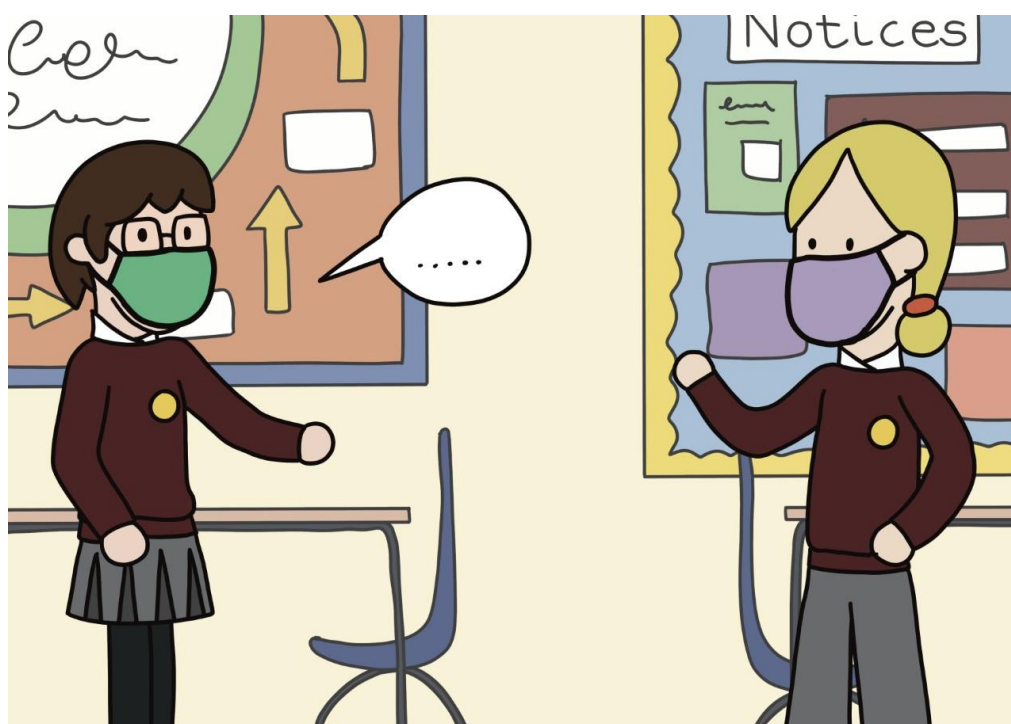
There will not be large, whole-school gatherings in school.

There are still many things that we can do in school!



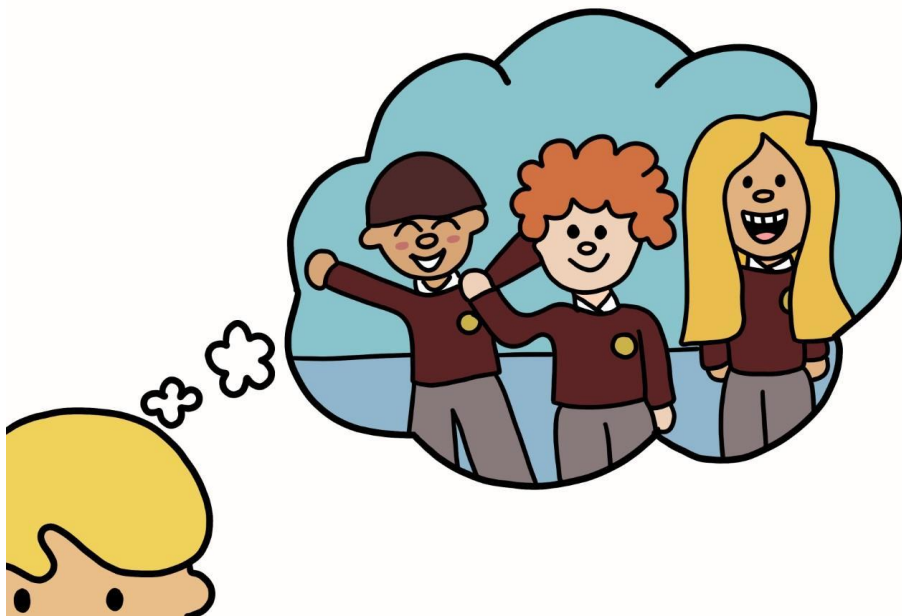
It will be nice to be in the classroom with our teachers and TAs again. It will be good to see familiar faces and socialise from a distance.
