Classroom Equipment

Homework Diary & Communication

- Pupils must keep it with them at all times.
- Used for recording homework and important events.
- Includes timetable and other useful information- timetables will be issued on the first day of school (Monday 5th Sept.).
- **To be signed weekly by pupil, parent and class tutor.**
- If you have any questions or concerns, please make contact with your child's tutor - this can be done by email, phone or a message written in the homework diary.

Transfer Day - Friday 1st July 2022

- Pupils will meet in the Sports Hall – please arrive between **8:40 - 8.45am**. (There will be senior staff to guide you to this area).
- You can either drop them off or wait with them in the Sports Hall. You will be able to wave them off as they go with their Tutor @ 8.50am
- Please pick your child up from the **Sports Hall at 3:10pm**.
- Please remember that we do not allow cars entry to the School Campus at the start and finish of the school day, but there is plenty of parking on neighbouring roads.

Transfer Day 1st July 2022

- Wear current school uniform

What should your child bring to school?

- a healthy snack (no nuts please!)
 - a named water bottle
 - a packed lunch - if you are entitled to FSM and have ordered a packed lunch, this will be provided
 - a sensible pencil case
- These can be carried in a small bag/ rucksack.

Medication Reminder

- If your child has any medication that they need to have in school (Epipen etc) this can be brought to the office after you have dropped your child off on transfer day as we will need a *permission to administer medication form* completed.
- You can then collect the medication at the end of transfer day and then return it to us on the first day of term (we will already have the consent form completed on Transfer Day).

Admission Form Reminder

- If you haven't yet, please complete the pupils admission form sent from our office
- Need all these completed before your child comes on Transfer Day.

First Day - Monday 5th September 2022

- **Drop off 8.15am:** ONE parent/carer to walk their child round the EMS side of campus & drop off at the Year 5 gate - senior staff will guide you
- **Pick up at 3.15pm:** staff will walk the children down and dismiss them from the main gate. Thank you for being on time for this dedicated earlier time slot for year 5 in the first week.
- No driving/ parking on site - lots of space in neighbouring roads

From Tues 6th Sept–Fri 9th Sept (Rest of the 1st week of term)

- **All 4 classes: drop-off at 8.15am and finish/ pick-up at 3.15pm.**
- **Drop off (8.15am):** Pupils will be guided from the main gate by EMS staff, through the Year 5 entrance gate to the tennis courts where they will line up with their Form Tutor .
- **Pick up (3.15pm): Please organise a place to meet your child outside the school gates.** The roads nearby get quite congested, so once they are confident enough, it is advisable to encourage your child to walk, bike or scoot at least part of the way.

From Monday 12th Sept onwards

- **Drop-off 8.25am with the rest of the school - registration at 8.40am**
- **Drop off:** Pupils to walk through the Year 5 entrance gate guided by Year 5 team
- **Pick up at 3.20pm, with the rest of the school:** Please continue to arrange a place to meet your child outside the school gates

- Please enjoy looking through this booklet with your child when they bring it home on Transfer Day (1st July)
- Lots of useful school information

Please read the following sections carefully:

- Stationery, uniform and equipment lists
- Extra uniform guidelines eg. Jewellery/hair/ make-up
- Mobile phones must be SWITCHED OFF before entering the school grounds in the morning. Pupils are **not** allowed to use their phones on school grounds. At the start of the school day, they must be placed in the Year Group phone box- these are then taken to the School Office for safekeeping and brought back at the end of the day for collection.
