Good afternoon and welcome to our latest weekly bulletin at the end of our first full week of 2023. The pupils have had a great week, settling back fully into all their routines and coping well with the unsettled weather and dodging the showers at breaktime!



Last term the Junior Duke offer here was launched and the take up has been fantastic. The higher the participation of the tutor group and their accuracy the more success.

On Tuesday we welcomed the parents of Year 6 children to share information about the 2023 SATs tests and also our activity days in the Summer term.
