Uniform

The start of the day is so important to ensuring your children have a positive day as it sets the tone. Please therefore support your child in ensuring that they arrive fully adhering to our uniform policy to ensure they can start the day unchallenged - the start of the settling process happens whilst still at home. Please check that your child has the correct clothing and footwear whilst also adhering to our policy regarding makeup and jewellery.

Reoccurring themes have included:

Makeup: Pupils are not permitted to wear make-up. This includes coloured lip balm and mascara. Cover-up concealer can be used to promote positive self-image.

Nails: Coloured nail varnish or false/gel nails of any type are not allowed and create a health and safety issue.

Earrings: Only a stud earring - one in each ear maximum is permitted

Shoes: flat, black, leather shoes

Coats: the weather is due to finally dry up next week but will bring some very cold conditions - pupils will be expected to stay in the supervised areas outside during break and lunchtime and as such a coat will be essential.

By checking these elements before your child arrives at school you are giving them the best possible chance to have a successful day.
